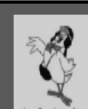

Energy bills...

The £100 heating oil payment is going to be provided to off the gas grid homes in a similar way to The Energy Bills Support Scheme. Therefore, it has been announced that the fund will be given via your electricity provider.

The government shared this quote:

"This scheme is intended to deliver a one-off payment of £100 to UK households who are not on the mains gas grid and therefore use alternative fuels, such as heating oil, to heat their homes. Powers will enable the government to deliver support via electricity bills in both GB and NI, under a similar delivery model to the Energy Bills Support Scheme. The payment will ensure that a typical customer using heating oil does not face a higher rate of growth in their heating costs since last winter, in comparison to those using mains gas, who are supported by the Energy Price Guarantee. The government will set out the timing of this payment soon."

Backs to the wall...

Walking a dog along the roads around Barningham, and particularly along Norbeck Bank, I'm increasingly struck by the variation in drivers' behaviour towards the pedestrian. Most, probably the majority, slow down, give the walker a wide berth, and acknowledge his or her keeping their dog to the side of the road. Others, generally in large SUVs and high-end cars, blast past with no attempt to slow down or change course, eyes fixed on the road ahead and seemingly oblivious to anything or anybody on the road. Walkers with dogs on leads and under control have as much right to use the highway as anyone else; they should not have to dive into the hedge, or flatten themselves against the wall, to escape arrogant, inconsiderate and dangerous drivers. So please, can everyone just slow down a bit for a few seconds? It won't make any real difference to the time you arrive at your destination. Burrell's bus drivers are invariably considerate and, if they can be so in much larger vehicles, so can everyone else.

Up to now, when approached by a car, I have always stopped and pulled the dog to the side. Henceforth I think I'll walk slowly down the middle of the road.

[Inconsiderate driving behaviour in Barningham, at least, is a problem. It's not just an issue of speeding, since in many areas the maximum limit of 30mph is simply too fast: there is a lot to be said in support of the "20 is plenty" movement. There have been significant modifications to the Highway Code, particularly in relation to the hierarchy of vulnerable road users – and, yes, pedestrians are road users and at the top of the hierarchy.
