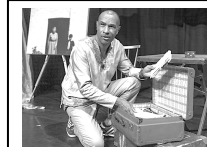

Peter David Johnson, 5 Sep 1944 – 10 Oct 2023

Sadly, another member of the Barningham Old Brigade has passed on. Peter David Johnson, was a quiet man and his accomplishments went largely unnoticed. He was a practical man who could turn his hand to most things. Dave, as most people knew him, died on Tuesday 10 October; his failing health finally caught up with him.

Dave and his wife June came to Barningham in the early 1980s, when they faced the mammoth task of rebuilding North View. Dave learned how to be a roofer, plumber, joiner and poultry farmer.

The Village Hall Committee press ganged him into their ranks and his skills as an accountant were valued and he was a key worker in all the big events from the Ceilidh to Valentine's Night and other events that required a cook. He was certainly an excellent cook and host, ever watchful for an empty glass. His gourmet tastes were acquired as a waiter in the restaurant of a posh hotel and later in French vineyards and Greek villages. His wine cellar was always well stocked.

Dave's one failing was a blind devotion to British Leyland cars, unashamed of his ownership of Rovers 45 and 75, a Triumph Stag and a dilapidated Land Rover. Nobody will ever understand why he spent most of his time repairing yet another broken upper cam shaft bearing or something equally baffling. In his later years he gave up and bought a Honda.

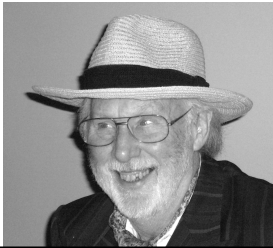
When he relaxed with a drink he was witty, profound and excellent company.

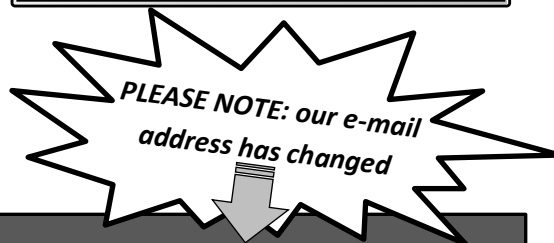

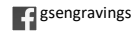
