





## **WHORLTON & WESTWICK NEWS**

Whorlton Bridge Repairs: VolkerLaser has made progress with cable crane installation over several weeks. This is a complex structure designed specifically for this bridge. There are two towers: South is 12.5m high, North is 8m high. There are five catenary cables spanning 95m between the towers. The central cable carries materials and bridge deck components during the dismantling and construction process. The two inner cables are aligned vertically to the bridge suspension chains and are used to lift, remove and re-install them. The two outer cables carry an under-deck platform which is operated by four remote control electric winches to pull it transversely across the river. The height of the platform can be adjusted using four hand-winches attached to the platform from the cables above. The cable crane is currently being commissioned.
