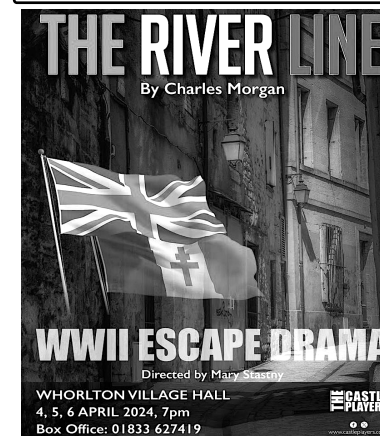

Unfortunately, we see a rise in burglary and theft offences at this time of year. There are a number of ways you can try to prevent this and make it as difficult as possible for thieves and opportunists: ensure you lock your doors when leaving your property, and also when inside your property – sneak-in burglaries are common and you would be surprised what somebody can get away with quickly whilst you are busy elsewhere. Make sure you lock your car overnight and keep your keys in your property out of sight. Most theft of/from vehicles occur when someone chances checking to see whether your vehicle doors are unlocked.
